You must not store inflammable liquids such as oil, petrol or paraffin in your house or in any storage or cellar area.

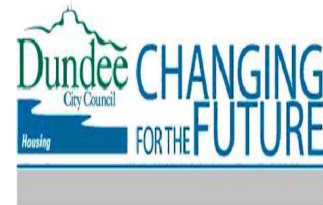
It is apparent residents are either unaware of this, or choosing to ignore it.
